Storms

We work to maintain a reliable power delivery system, but severe weather and other events sometimes cause power outages. Be prepared and know what to do should a power outage occur.

Have a plan

Prepare in advance by packing an emergency kit with food, water, flashlights, batteries and a charged cellphone power bank. If someone in your home has a critical medical condition, contact us to create an emergency plan.

Stay away

If you see a downed power line, consider it energized and dangerous. Stay at least 25 feet away and report it immediately.



Report your outage

If you experience a power outage, contact us right away. This helps us identify the outage and coordinate restoration efforts.



Stay informed with notifications

Use our app or sign in to My Account to sign up for outage alerts.

Help family and neighbors

After you are prepared, make sure family and neighbors also know what to do. Help them download our app and sign up for outage alerts. A little effort now will give everyone peace of mind.

Use caution near dams

We maintain hydroelectric stations and dams on public waterways in Wisconsin and Michigan's Upper Peninsula. The dams are vital to our total electric supply, but the facilities can be dangerous to unwary visitors.

If you're out on the water this summer, exercise caution. Stay a safe distance away from dams and obey all warning signs and signals.
